She has appropriate reactions to new situations.

When she is put in a new environment, she shows little to no signs of stress.
When she is exposed to a stressor like a bath or medical treatment, she shows little to no signs of stress.

When Petals White was introduced to noises or startling sounds, she noticed the sound and doesn't really react.
She was investigative when new objects were introduced and would quickly move to investigate. She is a little more confident to things that she sees rather than what she hears.

Petals White is showing very good focus that last over 15 seconds and will not break away even when distracted. Very good for learning and training!

She also has a high interest in higher valued rewards, which is another motivator for good training.

She loves food but has minimal interest in toys.

She, along with several of her siblings are motivated to problem solve, and are persistent to try and figure things out.

She is not very mouthy, but will use her mouth about half the time when trying to investigate something new.

During the test, she was vocal in stressful situations and socially appropriate ones.

She showed good control over the pressure of her bite when exploring with her mouth. Leaving no marks on skin or damage to toys.

When handled she was comfortable and tolerant of handling.

She demonstrated no possessiveness with her siblings or the tester with toys or food.

Overall, the Petals litter has a moderate energy level. She is motivated to interact and figure things out with little to no signs of stress in the process. She works to engage and stay engaged with the tester but may stop or get distracted.
